

LEXICON (WORDS)


A LEXICON IS A SET OF WORDS AND PHRASES. LEXICAL RULES ARE OFTEN IMPLEMENTED WITH CODE LISTS FOR A GIVEN VALUE. FOR EXAMPLE, WHAT WORDS CAN BE USED TO DESCRIBE "STATUS"?

SEMANTICS (MEANING)

SEMANTICS ENSURES A COMMON UNDERSTANDING FOR A GIVEN TERM WITHIN AN INFORMATION EXCHANGE.
FOR EXAMPLE, WHAT DOES THE TERM "YOUTH" MEAN?

SYNTAX (EXPRESSION)

SYNTAX ENSURES TERMS ARE EXPRESSED THE SAME WAY. THIS MIGHT INCLUDE SPECIFICATIONS FOR CERTAIN CHARACTERS. FOR EXAMPLE, CAN THE FIRST NAME "3RIC" BE ACCEPTED?
